- Swearing, Aggressive or other Inappropriate Language
- Excessive Alcohol Consumption
- Other Behavior deemed Inappropriate

Failure to refrain from above items may result in disqualification from an event or entire tournament at bowler's expense.

TOURNAMENT QUALIFICATIONS AND RULES

- Entry form must be completely filled out and signed by the Team Captain or some member of team acting as its representative.
- Deadline for entries for a particular shift is 20 minutes prior to that shift.
- Captains or representatives must report to Tournament Director 20 minutes before starting time to check line-up and averages or make substitutions if necessary. Deadline for substitutions is 10 min prior to start of shift.
- Whenever it is impossible to give an entry the time requested, notification will be sent to team captain or representative for additional choice.
- All Bowlers from CTF sanctioned leagues are eligible. Eligible non-members may qualify by paying \$24.00 unattached fee for CTF (Rule 324) or a CTF participation fee of \$5.00 for the tournament only.
- Captains and bowlers must verify extensions and additions on their score sheets at time they leave the lanes. Errors
 and omissions in scores and handicaps must be called to the attention of Tournament Committee prior to end of
 Tournament.
- Re-rating requirements: All bowlers are cautioned to be familiar with Rule 319e, 319b, 319c, 319d and 319F
- Bowlers will use their highest 2016-17 ABC/WIBC or CTF Standard Average (minimum 21 games). CTF Sport or Challenge Averages will be converted as per the CTF conversion table.
- If a bowler's 2017-18 Standard average (minimum 15 games) exceeds their highest 2016-17 Average by 10 pins or more, then the 2017-18 Average shall be used.
- All other bowlers will bowl scratch.
- 90% handicap, Scratch mark for singles and 9 pin tap events are 225 (A division) and 175 (B division), for doubles events 450 (A division) and 350 (B divisions) and for teams event 900.
- No tournament winnings need be reported.
- Prize Money will be paid out at a ratio of 1 for every 6 entries.
- 100% of Prize money will be paid out.
- Other rules will follow CTF Rules and Regulations in effect this season.
- Multiple Entries in all events is permitted however CTF Rule 317 is in effect and thus in order to place more than once
 in the prize list of position standings;
 - a) In the Team event, at least 2 players in the lineup must be different.
 - b) In the Doubles events, at least one player in the lineup must be different
 - c) In the Singles or 9 Pin Tap events, the same individual may not place more than once.
- Bowler's are responsible to verify the accuracy of his/her average in handicap tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowler, his/her team captain or others.
- Failure to use the proper average or make a correction up to completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than the actual average or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher.
- Other decisions will be at the discretion of the Tournament Manager in accordance with CTF Rule 304 Management.
- Final Deadline for entries to Annual Handicap Tournament is March 11, 2018 at 10:45 a.m.
